• Personal information received from any candidate will be treated as confidential and the identity of any candidate will only be revealed to an employer after prior permission from the candidate.

Note regarding protection of personal data:

In accordance with the Spanish "Reglamento General de Protección de Datos" based on the European Regulation EU 2016/679 about protection of personal data, Arne Beyerholm, as responsible for the records informs you about the following:

• The personal data, which we ask you to provide, will be kept in a record with the objective of matching your qualifications and expectations with specific job offers.

• We will only maintain and use information about you, which you have provided yourself. We ask all candidates to forward their CV (with the contents you find relevant). Once we have received your CV, we will forward a link to our Candidate Questionnaire, where we inform you about how we handle your personal data and give you the options of accepting this or rejecting it. In the latter case we will delete all information received from you.

• We keep the following personal information about you: Your CV, the filled-in Candidate Questionnaire, your diplomas (in some cases) and notes from any contacts to you, including job interviews. If you provide any further information voluntarily (e.g. a cover letter, diplomas, certificates or references), then we will obviously keep and use that information.

• Look Abroad! does not need and does not want to receive sensitive personal data, which are not relevant for understanding your qualifications and job expectations. Please do not provide us with information related to health, race, ethnic origin, political standpoint, religious belief, ideology, or union membership (the Spanish "colegios"). Further, please avoid including your DNI (personal identity number) in your CV.
